

Travel Awards for Accepted Abstracts at the 3rd IWGGD Symposium

### Dear Investigators,

We are delighted to announce an exciting opportunity for those who will be presenting their work at the 3rd International Working Group on Gaucher Disease (IWGGD) Symposium, taking place in Trieste, Italy, on 3–6 May 2026.

As part of our commitment to supporting the next generation of researchers and to fostering global participation, the IWGGD will once again offer **Travel Awards** to eligible **young investigators** and participants from **countries with limited access to research or travel funding** who have accepted abstracts.

### **Eligibility Criteria**

- Applicants must be students (medical or master's degree and above), or early-career researchers (within 3 years of completing an MD or PhD).
- Must have an accepted abstract (poster or oral presentation) for the 3rd IWGGD Symposium.
- Applicants should not be receiving full travel support from other sources.
- Researchers [ineligible under the first criterion] from countries with limited access to
  funding may submit an application for special consideration (should be detailed in the support
  letter).

## **Application Process**

- 1. Ensure your abstract has been accepted for presentation at the symposium (abstract submission deadline: **15 December 2025**).
- Submit a support letter from your supervisor (or, if not applicable, a brief personal statement) confirming your involvement in the GD field and stating that you are not receiving other travel support.

## **Travel Award Details**

• The acceptance letter and the amount awarded are expected to be sent to the applicant in February 2026.
